Visit the Oldest Olive Tree in the World – Ano Vouves

In the village of Ano Vouves, discover the world's oldest recorded olive tree, declared a natural monument. Estimated to be between 3,000 and 5,000 years old, it continues to bear fruit to this day. Its base was once a wild olive tree, later cultivated with the Tsounati variety. The tree's remarkable trunk, shaped by centuries, has a circumference of 12.5 meters and a diameter of 4.6 meters—truly a living piece of history!

Explore the Pnevmatikakis Winery

Next, we visit the family-run Pnevmatikakis Winery, known for its deep roots in Cretan winemaking. Discover fascinating details about the island's wine tradition and sample a variety of award-winning local wines.
