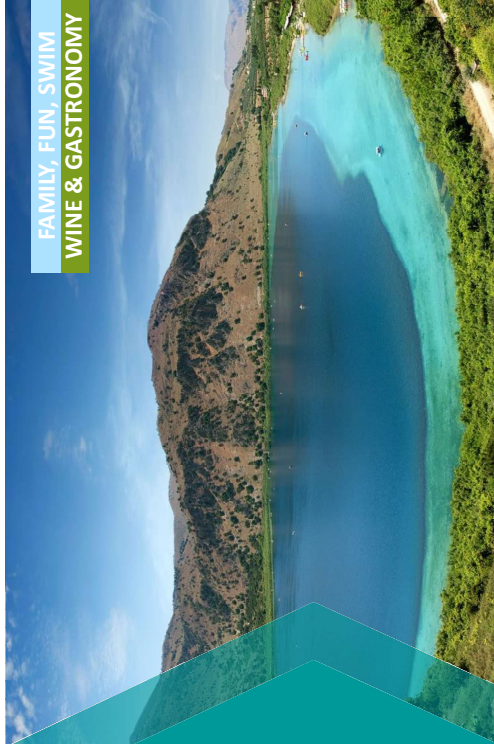

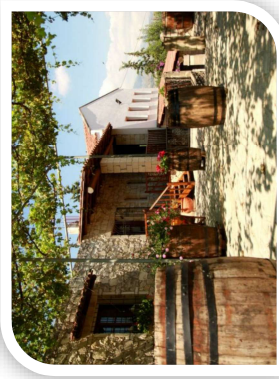

Kournas Lake

Kournas lake was known as Korisia in antiquity and is nowadays a destination attracting thousands of visitors every year. The lake's water increases during winter, from adjacent sources in the mountains and decreases in summer revealing a gold sandy strip.

The shallow clear waters at the shore gradually get darker towards the centre of the lake, reaching a maximum depth of 22.5m. Gaze at its surface mirroring the green surrounding, a safe haven to the area's avifauna and protected by the Natura 2000 program. The landscape is lovely and relaxing, either for a walk in the protected wetland or for riding a pedal inside the lake of Kournas.

Kanakis Olive Mill & Dourakis Winery

KANAKIS olive mill factory was founded in 1999 in the southwest part of GREECE which in ancient times was the kingdom of King NESTOR. Since then Kanakis family makes a top quality olive oil. Olive oil comes from the best olive variety named KORONE; it is produced at low temperatures of elision (28 degrees COLD PRESSING).

Surrounded by the beautiful natural habitat of this lovely island of Crete, this stone winery was built lovingly by Andreas Ntourakis, over the years with his own hands, providing the Ntourakis family with a unique identity in this part of Crete. A small ancient stone 'press' in the yard amongst the vines is proof that this place was a location for both the growing of vines and wine production as early as the Minoan period. The curved stone press was waterproofed with volcanic earth, probably from Santorini. However, this wine press had to be replaced later by a modern press in the winery due to the difficulty of transporting grapes to the original press.
